2011 CACCP Priorities

Rogue Sites:

- Secure enactment of legislation that gives the federal government increased authority to cut off websites dedicated to counterfeiting and piracy from the U.S. market.

Dedicated Resources:

- Ensure the IPEC has sufficient staff, budget, and authority to fulfill the obligations and achieve the goals outlined in the PRO-IP Act.
- Secure enactment of CBP reauthorization legislation with strong IP enforcement provisions
- Secure continued funding for dedicated resources at Justice and the FBI

Improved IP Enforcement Rules:

- Secure enactment of legislation that improves Special 301 enforcement and expands the IP Attaché program
- Enhance criminal penalties for illegally streaming copyrighted content
